Why a citation guide for MLA? • In your text, you should include a parenthetical citation each time you directly quote or paraphrase from another source. • Each of the in-text citations in your paper should have a corresponding full citation in your Works Cited list.

#### **APA Tip Sheet Publication Manual of the American ...**

In-text citations give credit to a person's ideas or creations in the body of your paper or assignment, such as when quoting or paraphrasing. In-text citations refer the reader to the full reference list at the end of your paper. Examples: One author: (Butler, 2015) Two authors: (Duggan & Murphy, 2019) Three or more authors: (Cole et al., 2011)

Body: Do not begin the body of your paper with "Introduction." The first part of the manuscript is assumed to be the introduction.
