The Gettysburg Address Gettysburg, Pennsylvania November 19, 1863 During a three-day Civil War battle at Gettysburg in early July 1863, there were over 23,000 Union casualties (including more than 3,000 deaths) and 28,000 Confederate casualties (including at least 4,000 deaths). A portion of the battlefield was dedicated as a

Thomas Ruger, Brigadier General, U.S.

1863 July 1-3: Commanded a division at Gettysburg. Brigadier General Ruger was sent to New York City to establish military control during the Draft Riots. 1864 November 30: Commanded a division on the main line at the Carter House. He was promoted to Brevet Major General for his service at Franklin.
